一、Übersetzen Sie den folgenden Text ins Chinesische: (20 分)

Je ärmer eine Person aufwächst, umso geringer sind auch ihre Chancen auf einen guten Bildungsabschluss, und umgekehrt. Um daran etwas zu ändern, muss zum einen die Bildungspolitik dafür sorgen, dass den Kindern aus armen Familien durch vorschulische Einrichtungen und Ganztagschulen eine Möglichkeit geboten wird, die familiär bedingten Defizite zumindest ein Stück weit auszugleichen und abzubauen.

Zum anderen muss die Sozialpolitik direkte materielle Versorgungsprobleme beheben, denn die bildungspolitischen Maßnahmen allein reichen nicht aus. Die Konzentration von armen Familien in bestimmten Wohnvierteln und die schlechte Infrastruktur dort machen es sehr schwer, eine gute Ausbildung zu bekommen, weil oft allein schon die Adresse ausreicht, um bei der Vergabe von Ausbildungsplätzen leer auszugehen. Auch das Fehlen öffentlicher Einrichtungen wie Büchereien oder Schwimmbäder erschwert den dort aufwachsenden Kindern den Erwerb von notwendigen Qualifikationen.
