成長

曾經在書上讀過幾句話：「當你自覺青澀，你便開始成長；當你自認成熟，你便開始腐敗。」時光荏苒，我已忘了是在何時、何地讀過這段話，連書名也早已遺忘，但這段言簡意賅之語，卻始終根植於我的腦海之中，未有片刻或忘。誠然，「成長」是一個人終生的功課，只要人活著，「它」便註定要跨步向前、無休無止。
